By end of August Peter finally found his employment in a company, which produces light switches and electric sockets. He is working there as technician since October 1st. Afterwards I had to spend again time to look for a fixed employment and was also partially busy with housekeeping work - we just started to live in our new apartment and many things had to be unpacked and moved there. Also installation work remained (phone, DSL) and decoration work as well. Still out of job, I had then the opportunity to spend time with friends and my mom, and also we were able to visit a friend of ours in Italy during an extended weekend.

However, it was during that month when I finally was able to find my employment as an assistant in a real estate office (20 minutes away from our new home). Since December 1st I'm driving to and fro to that job with their business vehicle, a little "smart" car with their publicity on it. Also in December we got a 2-day visit from an Indonesian university graduate (also an SLBC graduate) with whom we've shared the apartment in 2002 during our Bible school (SLBC) time.

Also we're regularly visiting a church in Zurich, which has a weekly service held simultaneously in German and English. This is great because this allows Peter to improve his German language knowledge, which is advantageous at his new work surroundings.

At this season in our lives, God is doing a new thing and allows us to spend more time together as a married couple. Also we appreciate to have our own living privacy - our little kingdom - as we are now able to live by our self, in our own 2-room apartment, after having spent five years with roommates and family.

We hope, that you're doing well and that you've spent a wonderful Christmas with your family and friends. Of course, we would be excited to hearing also from you and about what is going on in your life as well!
